The Congress will take place the 05th-08th November 2014 at Cosmocaixa in Barcelona (Catalonia).

CosmoCaixa Barcelona is the Science Museum of the "la Caixa" Foundation in Barcelona, located at Isaac Newton Street, 26.

CosmoCaixa Barcelona was the first interactive Science Museum in Spain and has received several awards including the Best Museum of the Year Award in 2006 from the European Museum Forum.

Mission and objectives



The Congress title Land: quality of Life reflects the necessity to find a balance between land use, preserving the value of different human activities, and the need to preserve the natural environment. The Congress aims to facilitate the necessary dialogue and work to go forward in the achievement of this objective through the development of land stewardship.

During the Congress people will learn from each other's experiences, will discuss different perspectives of land stewardship and will be able to propose innovations for and improvements to the implementation of stewardship as a conservation tool.





Declaration on Land Stewardship



During the Congress, the **Barcelona Declaration on Land Stewardship** will be elaborated and signed. The Declaration will define the Vision and Mission statement through a collaborative process that will help to identify synergies between actors with the aim to work together for the promotion of land stewardship both at the regional and European level..

The Declaration will be officially presented the **07th November 2014** and it will be the starting point for a new **European network** that will further develop land stewardship in Europe

We aim to:


Reduce the environmental impacts of the congress;
